Save Arrangement

Choose Song: Choose the song you would like to rehearse using this pull down list.

Tempo: If you want to slow down the speed of the music while you are learning your song, use this slider.

Vocal Parts: You can mute the other 'voices' so that you are just listening to your part. In this example, I am only listening to Mary's part and the piano accompaniment. On Mary's part, I have also changed the instrument and turned up the volume to make it stand out from the piano.

Recording: As RehearScore can only be accessed on a computer, many people find it useful to record the songs on their phone. Use the above tips to set the speed and vocal parts the way you want them, then use Voice Memos or another recording app. Once the songs are on your phone, you can rehearse wherever you are!

Markers: These help you to start the song at a specific section. In this example, the music will start from bar 120 where All characters sing "Just a spoonful of sugar..."

Exit Vamp: If your song seems to be getting 'stuck' in one spot, there may be a *vamp* or *repeat* written in the music. To make the music keep going, you need to press the Exit Vamp button each time you reach that point in the song.

Saving: If you want your settings, like speed and volume, to stay the same next time you use RehearScore, you need to press the Save Arrangement button to save your work before you exit the program.
